

How to Create a self-introduction Video

Application for **OT03-020** - “Immersive English Experience for Study-Abroad Preparation Program”

Guidelines for the introduction video:

Make the video in a quiet location.

- You can use your smartphone.
- Remove your mask.

The video should be no longer than 2 minutes
(about 1 minute is fine).

First, introduce yourself:

- Give your name and student ID at the start of the video.
- Do not read your speech. Look at the camera.
 - If using notes, only use keywords, and look at them only if needed.
- Do not have any long pauses. Speak as smoothly as possible.

Evaluation Criteria:

Next, make sure your speech answers the following questions:

- Why do you want to improve your English?
- Why do you want to experience a different culture?
- What have you done to improve your English in the past?
- You can include any other details that you think are relevant.

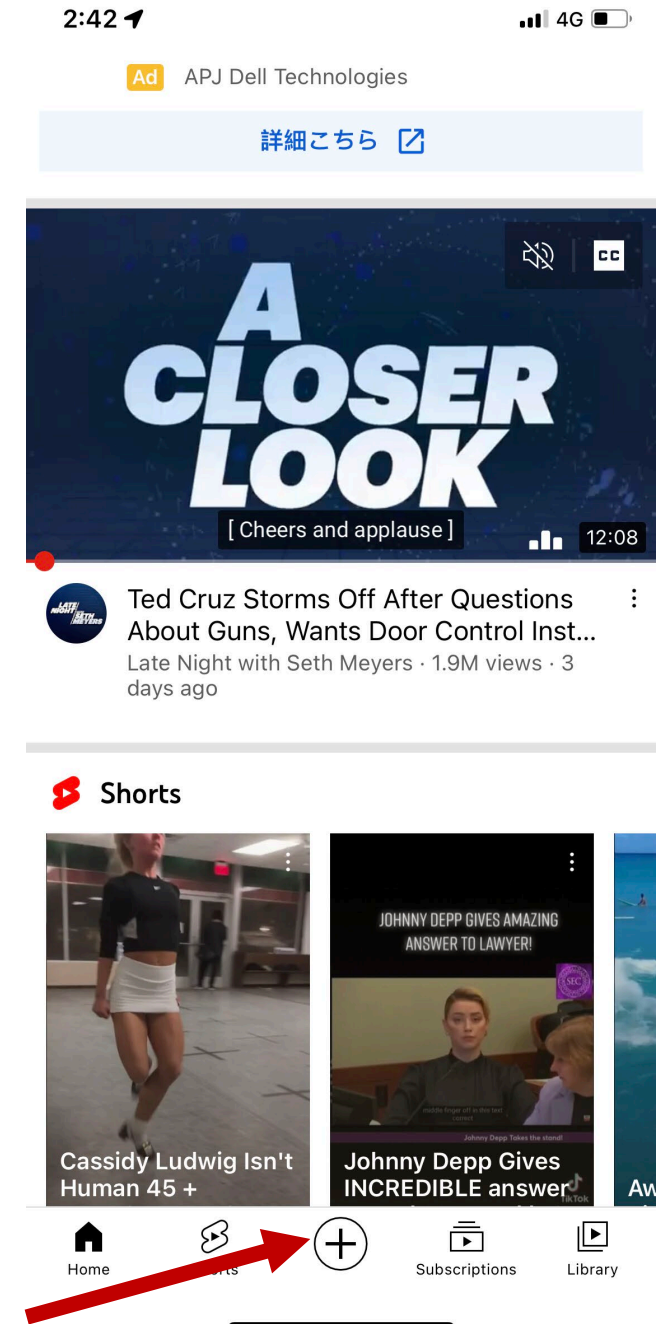
1. Create a video using your smartphone as a camera

Create an mp4 file (or any other file type that can be uploaded to YouTube).

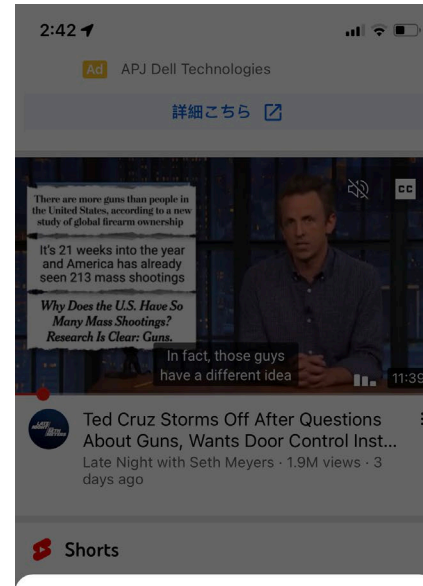


2. Open the YouTube app.


- Click the + button to share your video on Youtube.



3. Click on 'Upload a video'.

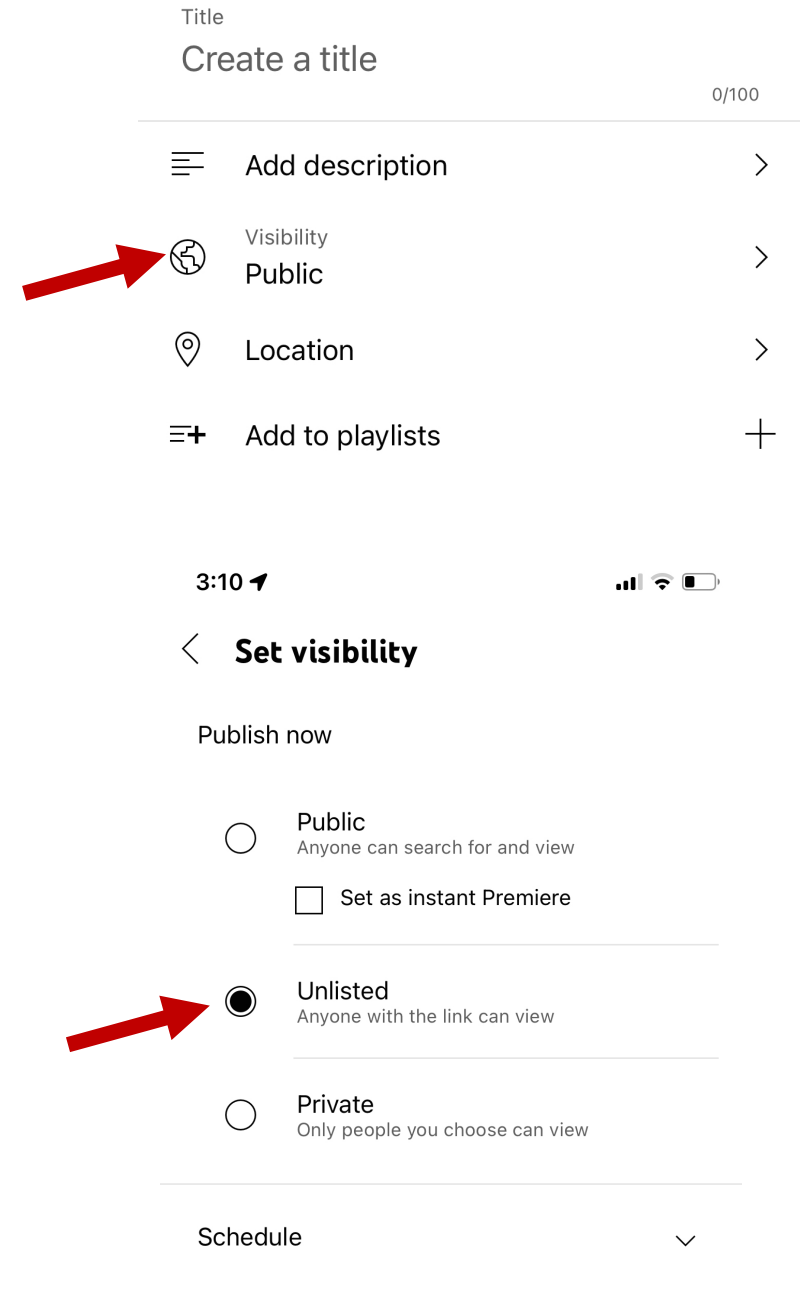
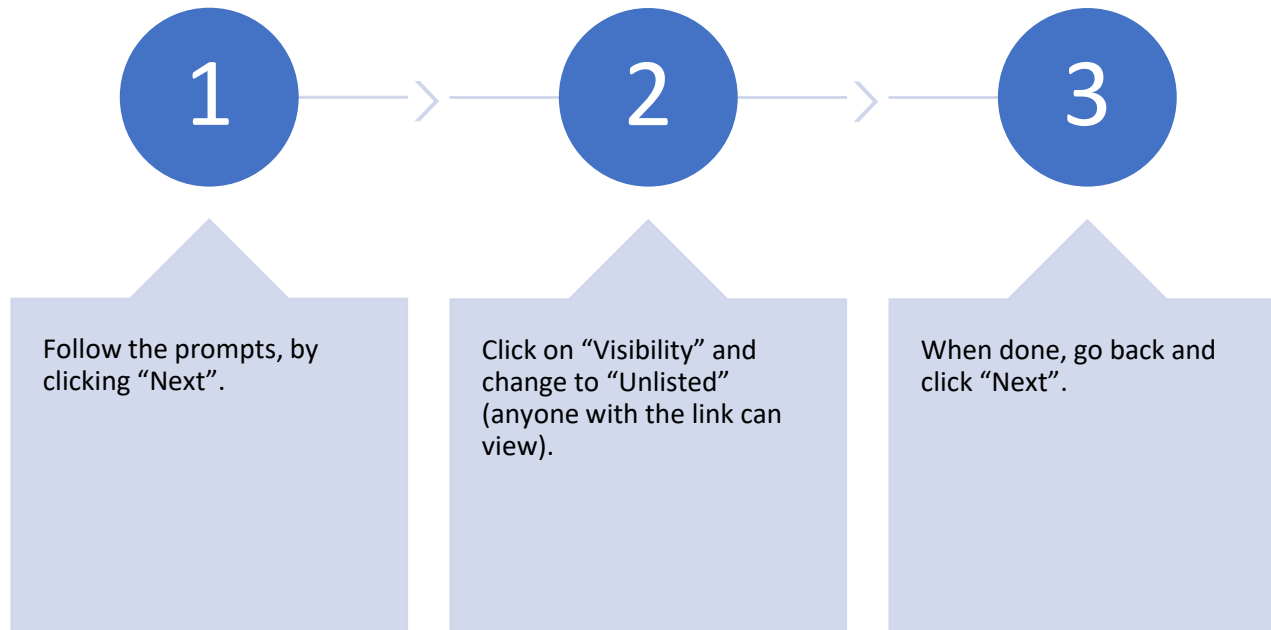

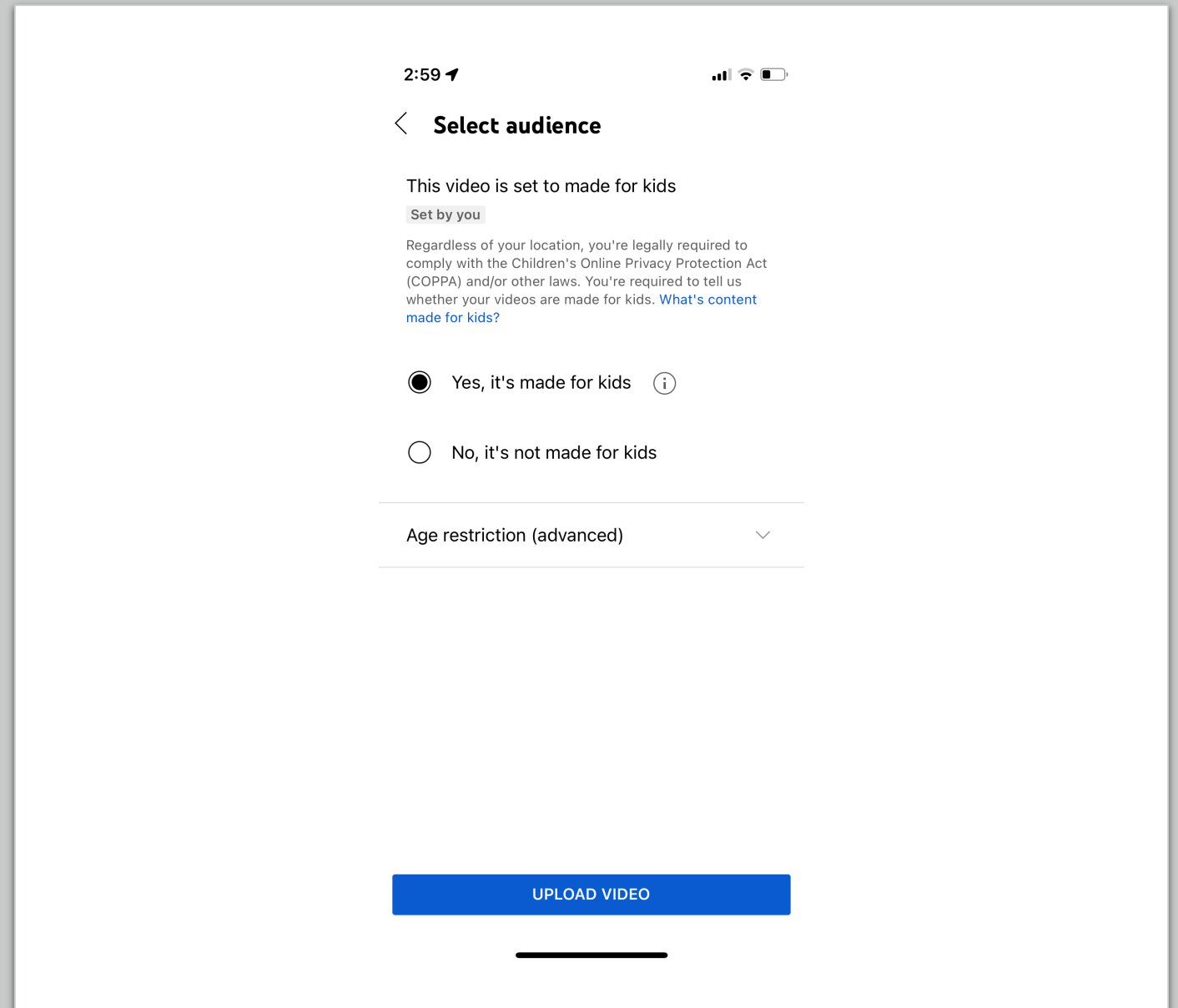


4. Choose your video.

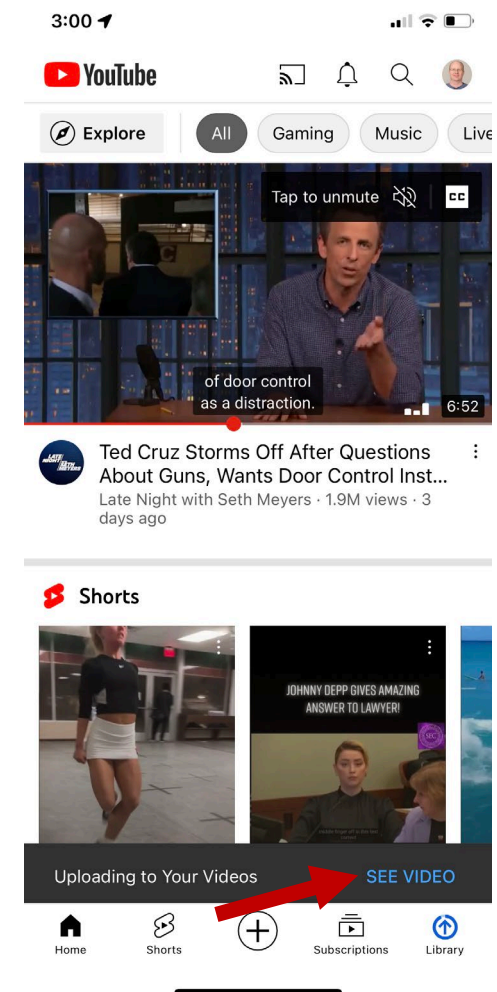


5. Select Audience and Upload

- Then click on “UPLOAD VIDEO”.

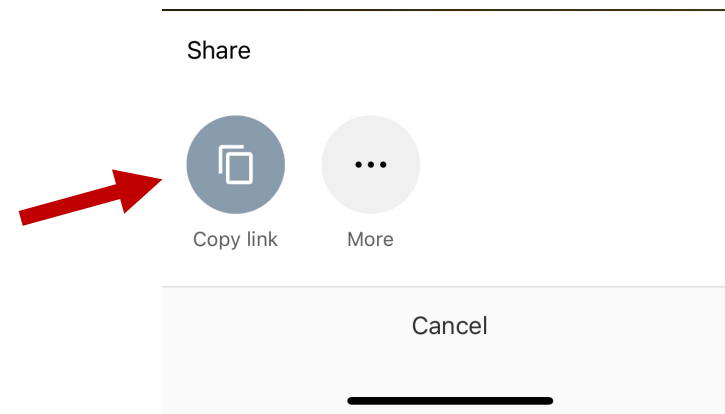
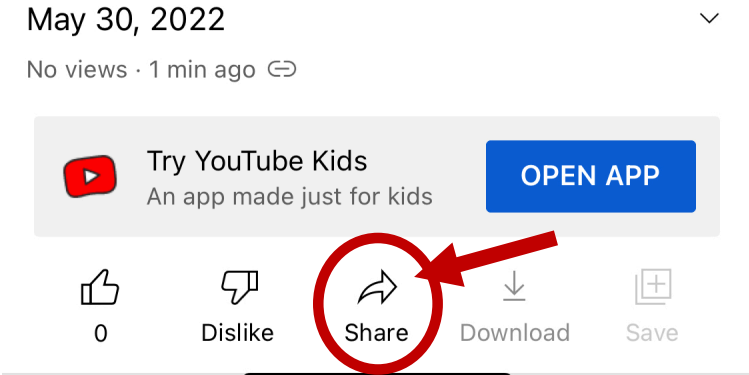


6. Click on “See Video” or “Your Videos”.



7. Share the video.

- Click on “Share”.
- Then click on “Copy link”.



9. Add the URL to your application web page.
